 time to die. Doth think proper to make this
 my last Will and Testament in manner and form
 following to Wit—

And first and principally I Recommend my Soul
 to God who gave it hoping by the merits of his
 Son to obtain pardon for all my sins and my
 body to be buried at the Discretion of my Ex^{ors}
 and my Desire is that all my Just
 Debts be justly and foremostly paid—

And first I Give to my well beloved Wife Ann
 Peach the Plantation and Tract of land live
 containing 182 Acres. Likewise I Give
 my House hold Furniture Beds Chests Out
 lets my Waggon Geese Horses Cows Sheep
 Pigs and all my Working Tools this I Give
 to my well beloved Wife as long as she Rem^s my
 Widow in order to maintain my Children, But if
 my Family moves to South Carolina I Give my

Exec^{or} to sell the Land and I allow my Wife
 Absalom to make a Right to the Land and take
 Money and buy other Land for my Children to
 raised on it they do not buy and with the Money
 to keep it and if my Widow marries a discreditable
 Person such as is good to the Children she may
 keep them if my Ex^{ors} think proper. But if
 Used bad to take them and put them to some
 creditable Good People, likewise as my sons come
 the Age of twenty one to have their parts of
 moveable property, likewise my three Daughters
 as they come to the Age of Eighteen for them to
 to have their equal parts as my Ex^{ors} think
 proper if my Family move from this place and
 no Land my Desire is that when my youngest son
 come to the age of sixteen for each Child to have
 equal part of the money that my Land was sold
 for, but if she pleases to stay on my place
 for to remain there as long as she lives or the
 Hood and at her Discease for the Land to be
 and Money Divided between my Children

Desire for my Mother to be maintained in
 Family if she stays if she goes away
 let her have one Leather Bed and my De
 is that all my moveable property be
 by two Freeholders & true acc^{ts}
 by my Ex^{ors} & it is my Desire for
 my Wife Ann Peach Abigail Peach &
 Thompson Miller to be my sole Ex^{ors}
 and this my last Will and Testament
 annulling all Wills and Bequeaths
 one heretofore made Ratified and confirm
 this and this only to be my Last Will and
 Testament as witness my hand and seal this
 day of February 1792
