

In the name of God Amen James Rife of Orange County and state of North Carolina, being of sound mind memory calling to mind the mortality of my body do make Ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner and following that is to say Imprimis it is my will that after my just debts and funeral expenses shall be paid out of my Estate by my Executors hereafter named, I lend unto my wife Margaret during her natural life all my Estate both real and personal and after her decease to be disposed of in manner here after set forth (to wit) I give and bequeath to my Daughter Jane Smith the sum of Ten shillings to her, her heirs and assigns forever, to be paid by my Executors hereafter named Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Ann Maria after the decease of my said Wife all the rest and residue of my Estate both real and personal to her, her heirs and assigns forever;

And I hereby appoint my said wife Margaret and my Daughter Ann Maria & John Ellerins my Executors of this my last Will and Testament, revoking all other Wills and Testaments by me made In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this Day of December 1792

I know ye that I Robert Andrew of Orange
County in the State of North Carolina considering the
uncertainty of this life do this twelfth day of the first
month in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred
and Ninety one make and publish this my last Will and
Testament in manner following That is to say first I
wile that my body may be decently interred in ground
burying ground, Secondly, that my funeral Expences may
be paid, and then all my just Debts. First I bequeath
unto my son Peter Andrew my new entry of Land
so joining my Deeded Land, to his heirs and assigns
forever, Second I bequeath unto my Sons David &

Thomas Andrew their heirs and assigns forever my
Deeded Land it to be equally divided between them
Thomas to have the West end of said Land, Third
my Will is that my loving wife Sarah Andrew shall
have her maintenance during her life off the said Land
give unto my two Sons David & Thomas, I also bequeath
my loving wife one feather Bed & Bedding
