

In the name of God Amen I Mary Walton
 of the county of Orange and State of North Carolina
 being of a low State of health and weak in body
 but of perfect mind and memory calling to mind
 the certainty of death I do constitute and ordain
 this my last will and testament, committing my
 body to the dust from whence it came and my
 soul to the mercy of Almighty God: who gave it up
 as to what lawfully goods yet hath pleased God
 to bestow on me in this life I have devised and
 dispose of the same in the following manner
 and form, first I give and bequeath to my
 Daughter Mary Collins five shillings specie to
 her, her heirs & assigns forever.

Secondly I give to my Daughter Lemema Ward
 five shillings specie to her her heirs & assigns
 forever.

Thirdly and lastly where my late husband
 Nathaniel Walton did grant and devise to me
 in his last will and testament, during my natural
 life, and to be at my disposal at my decease,
 the sum of five pounds to be paid to me
 annually by and from the profits arising
 from his lands or estate and as the debtors
 of the said estate have failed to pay me the
 above mentioned sum of five pounds and the
 same is still partly due to me, and is at my
 disposal. I do give and bequeath the same sum
 of five pounds as expressed in the last will of the
 before mentioned Nathaniel Walton to my
 Daughter Keziah Ware to be at her disposal,
 which sum amounts to thirty pounds currency,
 it commencing from year 1786 until the date

And I further give and bequeath to my
 Daughter Keziah Ware my Best & favorite
 and one horse alas all what some of my friends
 which I now possess or shall hereafter possess
 to her, her heirs and assigns forever.
 and I constitute and ordain my well beloved
 Son-in-law Thomas Ware my sole Executor
 of this my last will and Testament thou-
 making void all other wills and Testaments
 heretofore made by me. In witness hereof I the
 said Mary Walton have set my hand and
 fixed my Seal this Nineteenth day of June
 in the year of our Lord one thousand seven
 hundred and ninety two.
