Sealing and delivering of these presents by George Frost  
of the County of Orange and State aforesaid the receipt  
whereof I do hereby acknowledge have bargained sold set  
over and delivered in plain and open market and by  
these presents do bargain and sell unto the said George  
Frost one Negroe Man named Bob to have and to hold  
the said Negroe Man Bob by these presents bargained sold  
unto the said George Frost his Heirs and Assigns forever  
and I the said James Wiles for myself & my Heirs and Assigns  
all and singular the said Negroe Man Bob unto the  
said George Frost his Heirs and Assigns against me the said  
James Wiles my Heirs and Assigns and against all and  
every other person or persons whatever shall and will  
warrant and forever defend by these presents In  
witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal  
this 8 day of November 1790

of the County of Orange and State of North Carolina do make  
and freely bear this Eighteenth day of September in the year  
of our Lord Christ 1790 Now being of perfect mind and  
memory and calling to mind that it is appointed for all  
men once to die As in the presence of God and before  
these witnesses declare this to be my last Will and  
Testament in manner and form following First  
that is to say I give up my soul to that great Judge  
the God of Heaven and Earth who gave it Secondly  
my body to be decently buried in a Christian and  
orderly manner, and afterwards all my last debts  
be paid and then my whole Estate both real  
and personal to be distributed and given in manner  
and form following that is to say first I give and  
bequeath to my Dear and well beloved wife  
Mary my Gray Mare Saddle and bridle also four  
head of cattle of her own choosing out of my stock  
together with their Calves also one bed and furniture  
of her own choosing further I order and desire  
that my said Wife shall have her living & support  
off of my said Lands as long as she continues a  
widow and if she should continue so to have it during  
her natural life secondly I will and bequeath  
unto my son William Craig on Mutton Coll  
one Calf together with two Cows & Calves of  
the second Chipping out of my stock & further I will  
and bequeath unto my son William
