 first It is my Will & desire that all my last debts be first paid
 secondly It is my Will & desire that my wife Elizabeth Davis have
 the use of all my property real & personal to
 support and school my Children during her widowhood or
 the duration of my son Gabriel or as long as any of my
 Children continues single But should she marry or when
 Gabriel arrives at the age of twenty one or when any of
 my Children marry then it is my Will & desire that all
 my Estate real & personal be equally divided between my
 said wife and my Children after she takes her share
 of any one of my Negroes which shall be her share
 It is further my Will that when a division takes place
 the portions of those not arrived at the age of
 Twenty one or who may not be married be put together
 again and divided again as they marry or come of age
 Lastly I do hereby constitute & appoint my Wife Elizabeth Davis
 Executor and Gabriel Davis Son of William Davis Executor
 to this my last Will & Testament given under my hand &
 Seal the 2nd day of November A.D. 1806

 to have and enjoy the use of all my real and personal Estate
 I give & bequeath to my Son Philip on the day of his death to be taken
 of the Old tract including that whereon he now lives taken off adjoining
 Captain William Gresham's land
 I give and bequeath to my Son William all of that part of my land
 whereon I now live which lies on the West side of the Creek to be bounded by
 Robert Springfield on the South by said Creek on the East and by the part
 above bequeathed to my son Philip on the North
 I give & bequeath to my Daughter Mary all of that part of the tract
 of land whereon she now lives which lies on the East side of the Creek bounded
 on the North by the line of the Old tract whereon Thomas formerly lives
 on the South by Robert Springfield & John Cooper on the East also all of
 my plantation with two houses & outbuildings and all my Stock of Sheep & Hogs
 I give and bequeath to my Son Philip the remaining part of my land of land whereon
 Thomas formerly lived after taking off the Thomas tract to my Son Philip
 as before mentioned in said to my Daughter Mary after removal together with the
 mill and also my Negro Peter with all the balance of
 my Estate not particularly bequeathed to the highest bidder and
 money arising therefrom to be equally divided after paying all my
 last debts and expenses between my said wife, Son, Daughter
 Elizabeth Patterson

And lastly My Will & desire is and I do hereby constitute and appoint & appoint
 my Son Philip Hall & James Gresham my whole & sole Executors
