Articles of agreement between Edward Davis & Ashburn Davis
Whereas it seems that the Will of Gabriel Davis dec'd gives to the
said Edward Davis and Ashburn Davis the lands whereon
the Widow of the said Davis dec'd now lives at her death or
either of them living at her death

Know all men by these presents that we Edward Davis
and Ashburn Davis do Covenant & agree between ourselves
that should either of us die before the death of Elizabeth
Davis Widow of Gabriel dec'd we are willing that our
Children should stand in our stead and possess the
lands and enjoy all the privileges thereof in the same
manner as if we were both to survive the said Widow and
divide the land and then divide or sell it to our Children
In Witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands and
affixed our Seals this 14th day of November 1866
