This Indenture made this 5th day of December in the Year of
our Lord one thousand seven hundred & Ninety Seven between
Ben. Douglass Esq; in behalf of the Master of the County of
Person & their Successors in Office of the said Court & Mr. Hood
of the other Part witnesseth that the said Ben. Douglass
agreable to an Order of the said County Court made the day & date
above written hath placed me bind unto the said Mr. Hood, Ludwell
Roberson an Orphan of the age of 6 years Next March to live after
the manner of an Apprentice & Servant until he shall attain
to the age of 21 years during all which time he said Master
faithfully shall serve him lawfull command every where
honestly obey he shall not at any time absent himself from
his said Masters service without leave, but in all things as
a good and faithful Servant shall behave towards his said
Master, and the said Mr. Hood with Covenant Promise & agree-
ment with the said Ben. Douglass that he will teach
Instruct or cause to be taught & instructed the said Ludwell Roberson
according to Law to read write &c also the art and mystery of
a Painter, and that he will constantly find & provide for
the said Apprentice during the term aforesaid sufficient and
Washing Lodging & Apparel fitting for an Apprentice & Servant
and also all other things necessary both in sickness & in health
in witness whereof the parties of these presents have
Interchangeably set their hands and affixed their seals,
