and State of North Carolina being weak in body, but of sound mind
& Memory. Whose be God do this 17 day of March in the Year
of our Lord one Thousand Seven Hundred & Ninety Seven, make
Publick this my Last Will & Testament

I Give Give my beloved wife the use & Benefit of my
Estate both Real & Personal for and during her Natural life
for the use & purpose of maintaining herself & my two Children
& Educating them; under the following Restrictions to wit
that no part of the unenclosed Ground which I bought of
William Green shall be cut down or cleared, or the same be
in any way sold, destroyed, & after the death of my said Wife,
I Give & bequeath the whole of my Estate, unenclosed both
Real & Personal unto my said two Daughters Easter
Southers & Elizabeth Lady to them & their heirs forever
to be Equally divided between them share & share alike

Lastly I do nominate I appoint my dear Robert Dickins & my
Bartholomew Law Matter & Public Executors of this my Last
Will & Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my
Hand & Seal this 17 day of June above said
