that I Elizabeth border of the County of Pasquot and State
of New Jersey for and in consideration of the sum of fifty
pounds four shillings lawful money of this State to me
in hand paid by Sarah border of the County and State
aforesaid the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have
bargained sold & delivered & by these presents according to
due form of law do bargain sell & do deliver unto the
said Sarah border and her heirs forever hereafter
of cattle marked very with cross & dot in the left
ear and hole in the right also another four marks
with cross & two dots in the right ear and cross and
underhook in the left together with of two cows and
firmature two dozen of butter plates three barrels and
two butter tishes seven head of hogs with all the brass
that is now on the ground to have and to hold unto the
bargained premises unto the said Sarah border her heirs
heirs & assigns forever and I the said Elizabeth
border for my self my heirs & assigns the bargained
premises unto the said Sarah border her heirs & assigns
and against all persons shall warrant and
forever defend by these presents from going either law
or persons whatsoever whomsoever I have hereunto set
my hand and affix my seal this 26 day of August
1792

This sheweth unto the 28th day of March in the year 1792
James John Paine esq. in behalf of his father James of the
County of Passaic and then deceased and alias of the
said Passaic and Richard border of the County of Passaic
testify that the said John Paine Esq. in pursuance to an order
of the Court made this day and date above written
did first show and laid unto the said Richard border
Sarah Patterson an orphan now of the age of three years
dead not yet to her after the manner of an apprentice
and do not intend she shall attain to the age of fourteen
years during all which time the said Master testifying
shall have his lawful commands every where going
they shall not at any time absent herself from
her said Master except in all things as a good and
faithful servant shall behave towards her said Master
And the said Richard border doth covenant promise and
agree to and with the said John Paine esquire that he
will teach and instruct and cause to be taught and
taught to the said Sarah Patterson learning to law to read
writing &c. also the Art and Mystery of a Farmer and
that he will constantly feed and provide for the apprentice
sufficient diet clothing lodging and apparel
fitting for an apprentice and do not intend she shall
bring away with her in writing and in death all things
which the Parties to these presents have voluntarily and
in hand & delivered then unto the day and year first above
written
