and state of North Carolina being sick of body both of perfect
mind & Memory do make & declare this to be my last will
and Testament in manner & form following

Item I give to my son Anderson Stone one hundred and fifty acres
of land part of the tract I now live on taking it on the west
End of the tract - Item the balance of the said tract I give
to my sons John Stone and William Bird Stone to be equally divi-
ded between them by selling a fine Shute by lands giving William
Bird Stone his part & giving that of Anderson Stone & John
Stone his part & giving of Bickley Jacobs to them & their
heirs forever, my other Estate I with the tract on Adams Creek & the
tract in North Carolina together with my Personal Estate or so
much thereof as will satisfy all my just debts I desire may be sold
at the discretion of my Executors and after my debts are paid of any
thing remaining I lend to my wife Mary Stone together with the plan-
tation I now live on, including fifty acres of wood land during her life
and after her Decease whatsoever remaining I desire may be divided
among all my Children to wit my three Sons already named &
Nancy Stone Elizabeth Susannah & Nathaniel Stone and do
appoint my wife Mary Stone John Guinn & William Allen
to be Executors of this my last will & Testament
