 pots and one Duck cover, one Shovel & two off books & one
 Churn, two water hails one Diggin, ^{to the only}
 proper use and behoof of him, the said Wall
 his Heirs & Assigns for ever from him the said
 Warren his Heirs Executors & Assigns & from
 every other Person or persons whatsoever can shall
 will or may lay any claim right title or Interest
 to the above mentioned Property the same being
