hath given Granted bargained Sold & Delivered and with  
hath given Grant Bargained Sold & Delivered unto the  
said Wall his Heirs & Assigns for ever, <sup>two</sup> certain  
lands and premises, consisting of four plantations  
Three Old Plantations two Shales and Counters, one  
Red Gum & one Red Oak, each marked thus a T in  
the right and a cross in the left one pine chest & two Elm  
Trunks, six chairs, two pine Tables & five pewter plates  
two pewter Dishes, one Case of knives and forks, two Iron  
bats and one Duck cover, one Sheet & two off books, one  
Churn, two water pails & one Piggins, To the only  
proper use and behoof of him, the said Wall  
his Heirs & Assigns for ever from him the said  
Warren his Heirs Executors & Assigns & from  
every other Person or persons whatsoever can shall  
will or may lay any claim right title or Interest  
to the above mentioned Property the same being  
Sold and Delivered to him the said Wall, for being  
Security for him, the said Warren for to
