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In the name of God Amen, I John Holloway sen. of Orange County, Petitioner of North Carolina being of sound & perfect mind & Memory, do hereby publish this my last Will & Testament in manner, following that is to wit

First my Just Debts are all to be paid out of my Estate - I give & bequeath the unto my son James Holloway the Tract of land wherein I now live called the old slavery containing two hundred & fifty acres more or less, also two hundred & fifty acres of land out of the new survey adjoining the tract wherein I live to be laid off as James Holloway may choose making his quantity five hundred acres, also the Negro man Stephen, & all my household furniture, & Plantation Utensils, only my Beloved wife Ann Holloway is to live with me son James & have her maintenance out of the above said & Property - I give & bequeath to my Daughter Mrs Parker, the Ballance of the new survey of land adjoining Robt. W. Farland's line containing three hundred & ninety acres more or less, also one cow & calf.

The Ballance of my Estate (Money) the Ballance of my stock of Cattle, my stock of horses, sheep, & hogs & debts due to me, after giving James Holloway my son two Cows Extra, - I give & bequeath to my four Children, John Holloway sen. William Holloway, Ann Parker and James Holloway, Equally Divided amongst the four having & appointing John Holloway sen. my Executor - In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 3rd day of May 1799
