 this my Will, which said bond is to be given to my Executors  
 I am fully Will and Pleasure is that all the remainder of my

Estate be sold by my Executors to the highest bidder and  
 after paying my said Debt, I give unto my Grand son  
 Anthony David Rogers Twenty Pound Current  
 Money of Virginia and all the remainder to be  
 Equally Divided between my said David's Children as  
 aforesaid including my Grand son Anthony —

I am I hereby appoint my Trusty & beloved Friends  
 Edward Clay Senr. Thos Barnett Esqr and Lewis Dixon as my  
 true & lawful Executors of this my last Will & Testament  
 which I Sign Rogers hath bound to set my hand &  
 affix to my head this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of June in Year of our  
 Lord 1797 —

 Georges State of North Carolina being in low state of health, bound of sound  
 mind & memory, thanks be to Omnipotent God for it, do make this statute  
 this my last Will & Testament in manner & form following. First  
 I do Will is that all my Debt, Debt, and Personal Estate be paid  
 Secondly I do to my beloved wife Eliza a better Barren & young  
 her Natural Life or Widowhood, all my land lying on the  
 West side of Prince Georges up to the mouth of the Fishing  
 Branch, thence up the said Branch, also the land on the East  
 Side of the Creek, that is above the road, that in the meantime  
 for her to have the use & benefit of as land, also my Negro  
 man named Dick, & my Big Bible and also one Part of my  
 Personal Estate to be left out to her by my Executors  
 in as best manner as they with Conscience can,  
 Except thirty pounds Virginia Money which I have  
 lodged in the hands of my son in Law Messrs Dixon  
 I do Give to my son Thomas Barnett Esq in charge of  
 of Plains Common Books, Item I Give to my son John  
 Barnett Ten Shillings & my Book called Book of Psalms  
 Item I Give to my son Charles Barnett all my land lying  
 on the East side of Prince Georges up to the mouth of the Fishing  
 Branch, thence up the said Branch as far as my land extends  
 only the use & benefit of that land, which we have the benefit  
 of on that side of the Creek, I leave to my Wife Eliza with  
 In during her Natural life, or Widowhood, Item my pleasure  
 is that my Daughter in Law Messrs Barnett shall have  
 the full benefit of that land, which I Give to my Grand  
 son Hugh Barnett so long as she supports her husband &  
 Will or remains in Widowhood, should it otherwise happen  
 then may my Executors take it to the use of my Grand  
 son, as they think best, should my Grand son, die before  
 he comes of age or his Landless they shall have then  
 my Pleasure is that the above land, I Give to my  
 son John Barnett and his heirs forever, —
