One Cotton, Set of Tea Cakes & Larders, also 10 doz. pewter plates, Two Waxen Two Drift, One large Pot, one small Dish One Dutch Oven &c. which property I hereby these presents Reigned & do release & confirmed unto the Only proper use and behoof of the said William Chamberlain
