Persons County and State of North Carolina for good Cause me
knows moving have made Charles Allen of Kentucky my true &
Lawful Attorney for me & in my name to settle & dispute any
and every Dispute that may arise or have been against my
Claims to as much of Lands lying in Kentucky in the fork between
the Blue Ridge Fork & the South Fork of the River either by Compa-
=nion, inheritance or by Law, as to my said Att. may deem best
and also to sue & convey any part or all of my said tract of Land
for such purpose as he shall see and singular to do & perform
in every other Matter and thing Concerning the said Land that I
myself could or ought to do therein were I personally present
& I do hereby ratify & Confirm any and every Act and Deed which
my said Attorney may do or cause to be done in the premises
as fully & completely as if I myself had been personally present
and performed the same. In Witness Whereof I have hereunto set
