bind unto the said Major Green an orphan named Betty Maston  
now of the age of Six years with the said Major Green to live  
after the manner of an Apprentice and Servant until the said  
Apprentice shall attain to the age of Eighteen years during all  
which time the said apprentice his master faithfully shall serve  
his lawful Commands every where whithersoever he shall not at any  
time absent himself from his said masters service without leave  
but in all things as a good and faithful servant shall behave  
towards her said master and the said Major Green doth covenant  
Promise and agree to and with the said Yancy Bailey that he  
will teach and instruct or cause to be taught and instructed the  
said Betty Maston to learn the art of a Spinster & also to read  
and write and that he will constantly feed and provide for said  
Apprentice during the term aforesaid sufficient diet washing  
lodging and apparel fitting for an apprentice and also all  
other things necessary both in sickness and in health in

the said Yancy Bailey Esq<sup>r</sup> that he will teach and instruct  
or cause to be taught and instructed the said Yancy Evans to learn  
to read & write the art and Mystery of a Spinster and that he  
constantly feed and provide for said apprentice during the term aforesaid  
sufficient diet washing lodging and apparel fitting for an apprentice  
and also all other things necessary both in sickness and in health
