This Indenture made the 21st day of Dec^r in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and two Between Gancy Bailey Chairman of the County of Person county and state aforesaid on Behalf of the Justices of the said County and there Successors of the one Part and Major Green of the other Part Witnesseth that the said Gancy Bailey in Pursuance to an Order of said County Court made the 21st day of Dec^r and according to the Directions of the Act of Assembly in that Case made and Provided doth put Place and bind unto the said Major Green an orphan named Betty Martin now of the age of 14 years with the said Major Green to live after the manner of an Apprentice and Servant until the said Apprentice shall attain to the age of Eighteen years during all which time the said apprentice her master faithfully shall serve his lawful Commands every where residing she shall not at any time absent herself from his said masters service without leave but in all things as a good and faithful servant shall behave towards her said master and the said Major Green doth covenant Promise and agree to and with the said Gancy Bailey that he will teach and instruct or cause to be taught and instructed the said Betty Martin to learn the art of a Spinster & also to read and write and that he will constantly feed and provide for said Apprentice during the term aforesaid sufficient diet washing Lodging and apparel fitting for an apprentice and also all other things necessary both in sickness and in health in Witness Whereof the Parties to these Presents have interchanged set their hands and seals the Day and year first above Written
