This Indenture made the fourth day of March in the year of our Lord one Thousand Eight Hundred & five between Henderson Haralson Chairman of the County Court of Person County & State aforesaid on behalf of the Gentlemen of the said County and their successors of the one part and George Gregory of the other part Witnesseth that the said Henderson Haralson in pursuance to an Order of said County Court made the fourth day of March and according to the directions of the said Order do assemble in that case made & provided doth put these things into the said George Gregory an Orphan named Peter Brockwell now of the age of three years & doth send with the said George Gregory to live after the manner of an Apprentice and servant, untill the said Apprentice shall attain to the age of Twentyone years during all which time the said Apprentice his Master & his heirs shall serve his lawfull Commands every where readily Obedy he shall not at any time absent himselfe from his said Masters service without leave first in all things as a good and faithfull servant shall be have towards his said Master and the said George Gregory doth Covenant promise & agree to & with the said Henderson Haralson that he will teach and instruct or cause to be taught & instructed the said Peter Brockwell when the Act of a Planter also to read & write and that he will constantly find and provide for said Apprentices during the term aforesaid sufficient diet washing Lardyn and Apparel fitting for an Apprentices and also all other things necessary both in sickness & in health
