The Indenture made the fourth day of March in the year of our Lord one Thousand Eight Hundred & five Between Honorable Henderson Chairman of the County Court of Person County & State aforesaid on behalf of the Gentlemen of the said County and their Surveyors of the one part and George Gregory of the other part, Witnesseth, that the said Henderson Henderson in pursuance to an Order of said County Court made the fourth day of March and according to the directions of the said Court in that case made & provided doth here bind unto the said George Gregory an Orphan Named Peter Brockwell now of the age of three years & less than with the said George Gregory to serve after the manner of an Apprentice and servant, untill the said Apprentices shall attain to the age of Twentyone years during all which time the said Apprentices his Master, lawfully shall serve his lawfull Commands every where readily Obedy. he shall not at any time absent himself from his said Masters service without leave that in all things as a good and faithful servant shall be have towards his said Master and the said George Gregory doth Covenant promise & agree to & with the said Henderson Henderson that he will teach & instruct or cause to be taught & instructed the said Peter Brockwell when the Act of a Planter also to read & write and that he will constantly feed and provide for said Apprentices during the term aforesaid sufficient diet washing & lodging and apparel fitting for an Apprentices and also all other things necessary both in sickness & in health. And the said Moses Street Esq doth Covenant promise & agree to & with the said Ballentine that he will teach & instruct or cause to be taught & instructed the said Peter Rogers to learn to read & write also to be a Planter & that he will constantly feed & provide for the said Apprentices during the term aforesaid sufficient diet washing & lodging and apparel fitting for an Apprentices and also all other things necessary both in sickness & in health.
