 made & in pursuance, with full plea and bond unto the said
 Margaret Sanders an orphan named George Pittard
 Son of the late of Eleven years with the said Margaret
 Sanders to live after the manner of an apprentice
 & servant until the said apprentice shall attain to the
 age of Eighteen years, during all which time the said
 apprentice when his Master's lawfulness shall some his
 lawful commands every where readily obey, she shall
 not at any time absent herself from her said Master's
 Service without leave but in all things as a good and faithful
 servant shall behave towards her said Master, and the
 said Margaret Sanders with covenant promise and agrees to
 and with the said Samuel Smith that she will teach
 and instruct in figure to be taught and instructed the said
 George Pittard to learn the art & mystery of a spinner and
 she will constantly feed and provide for said apprentice
 during the term of aches sufficient diet washing lodging
 and apparel fitting for an apprentice, and also all other things
 necessary both in sickness and in health, In Witness whereof these
 parties to these presents have interchangeably set their hands
 the day & year first above written.
