 This Indenture made the Seventh day of March in the
 year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Three
 between Samuel Smith Chairman of the County Court
 of Person County and State of North Carolina on behalf of the
 Justices of said County and their Successors of one part
 and Margaret Sanders of the other part Witnesseth that
 The said Samuel Smith in pursuance of an order of said
 County Court made this seventh day of March and according
 to the directions of the act of Assembly in that behalf
 made & in force, with full power and bound unto the said
 Margaret Sanders an orphan named George Pittsford
 Born of the age of Eleven years with the said Margaret
 Sanders to live after the manner of an apprentice
 & servant until the said apprentice shall attain to the
 age of Eighteen years, during all which time the said
 apprentice shall faithfully & lawfully shall serve his
 lawful commands & everywhere readily obey, she shall
 not at any time absent herself from her said mistress
 Service without leave but in all things as a good and faithful
 servant shall behave towards her said mistress and the
 said Margaret Sanders with covenant promise and agrees to
 and with the said Samuel Smith that she will teach
 and instruct in house to be taught and instructed the said
 George Pittsford to learn the art & mystery of a spinner and
 she will constantly feed and provide for said apprentice
 during the term of service sufficient diet washing lodging
 and apparel fitting for an apprentice, and also all other things
 necessary both in sickness and in health, In Witness whereof these
 parties to these presents have interchangeably set their hands
 the day & year first above written.
