& State of North Carolina all the following Property (to wit)
one Feather Bed & Furniture one dentate Case, one Dish,
and three plates, one Horns Ladder, one Cotton Wheel, one
Pail, one Trunk &c. and doth by these Presents give grant
make over and depand the Right Title & Interest of the
said above mentioned Property, To the said Henry Filson
& Chambers, his heirs or assigns from me my heirs &c.
& from every other Person or Persons whatsoever may
Can. shall or will lay any Claims Right or Title to
the above Property, Providing the said Henry Filson & Chambers
shall be obliged or made pay a certain sum of money
which he shewes security for to the Executors of John
Norton Dec^d for the said Mary Norton, but in Case
the said Mary Norton shall will & Truly discharge
the said bond herself then be the said Chambers is to
Release the above Property other way he is to have
the said Property above mentioned. Witness my hand
