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I know all men in these Presents that I do be Dinwiddie of
 North Carolina in the County of Person (for diverse Consideration
 & good cause me hereunto moving) have made certain, constituted and
 appointed, & by these Presents, do make certain, constitute & appoint my
 Trusty friend Thomas Kelly esq. in State & County aforesaid my true &
 Lawful Att^y for me, in my Name, as well in my Guardianship
 as Guardian for the Orphans of S^t. Dinwiddie Da^r. as in that of my
 Privilege, & to my use, to ask demand recover or receive all debts to
 me due & unpaid, either as Guardian aforesaid or otherwise, or
 Contracts to be due; also to act & do for me & in my name as
 aforesaid. Touching the Liquidating all accounts, selling or renting
 out my Land, Giving & by these Presents Granting to my said Att^y
 my full Power & authority to take Pursue & follow such
 legal courses, for the recovery, receiving & obtaining of all debts
 to me due or Contracts to be due, as I myself could do were I
 Personally Present, & upon the receipt of the same acquittance &
 other sufficient discharges for me & in my name to make
 sign seal & Deliver, as also on or now Attorneys, or Attorneys
 under him to substitute or appoint. & again at his Pleasure to
 revoke, & further to do Perform & execute for me & in my Name
 all & singular, thing or things, which shall or may be necessary
 touching & concerning the premises, as fully thoroughly & entirely, as
 I the said Rachel Dinwiddie, in my own Person, might or could
 do, in & about the same, & adding, allowing & confirming whatever
 my said Att^y shall lawfully do, or causes to be done by Virtue of

I William Gately, being of sound sense & M. memory,
helped be God - But calling to mind the Certainty of
Death & the Uncertainty of life, do make this my
last Will & Testament in manner following (S^{ign}) -
I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Ann Gately
the Tract of Land whereon I now live, one hundred
Acres more or less, after my wife's Death, to her and
her heirs for ever
I give & bequeath after my Wife's Death, all my
Personal Estate of all kinds whatsoever, to be equally
to be Divided among my Children - I do Appoint
my two sons Joseph Gately, & John Gately my
Executors of this my last Will & Testament
