Two Suits in part of my Estate or Item I give to my  
daughter Polly Harris one leather b. & chamberlain part  
of my Estate or Item I give & bequeath to my son Benjamin  
Harris one feather bed and furniture in part of my Estate  
Item I give & bequeath to my son Richard Harris one fifth of  
my Estate, Item I give and bequeath to my son Richard  
Harris one fifth of my Estate, and lastly I constitute and  
appoint Mr. Charles Parker Notch living in the County of  
State aforesaid To manage my Executors to sell & dispose  
of my stock of hoggs, horses cattle & household furniture  
and all my working tools, and my Land to be treated like  
my youngest child named ages & then to be Equally divided  
amongst my five children, And hereby revoke & cancel &  
disannul all former testaments with savings by me  
by me in any wise before named settled or begined to be writing  
and concluding this and in order to be my last will  
and testament the witness whereof have here wrote set  
my hand & affixed my seal.

lands I am possessed with and give negroes to my son  
Lyne, Charles, Moses, & Solomon & my daughter  
Sarah Harris my Negro man named Callus &  
son and my negro woman named Nancy & two negroes
