In the Name of god amen. I David Michell del of the County of New
 & State of North Carolina being in firm & sound disposing mind
 & Memory do make & Ordain This my last Will & Testament In presence
 I Will that my Last Debts & Funerals Charges be faithfully discharged
 by my Executors hereafter named. I then Give & bequeath to my beloved
 wife Elizabeth Michell Two Negroes Viz. Ben & John. during her
 old & widowhood which at her decease I do Will the same Negroes Ben & John
 to my Son William Michell, also I Give to my wife Priviledge of
 all the Goods with all my slaves & all her furniture together with all
 Debts due either by Note or book accountable for her & discharge of as she sees
 Reason. at her death, also I Give that my son William Michell whom I
 Constitute & Appoint to Collect & settle the said Debts. I then Give &
 bequeath unto my Son Will^d Michell my Land & Town Place now in the
 Co. of Brunswick thenceforth belonging except what lies the west side of
 a branch that empties into Edges at the Wagon Trade then I Give to
 my Son William Michell, One hundred Acres Land lying in Brunswick
 on the Waters of Stono Creek above James Brooks now lived
 together with four Negroes, Viz. Sam. Sam. Is. Henry. & Andrew. I then I
 Give & bequeath to my son David Michell, A Certain Piece of Land lying
 on the West side of a branch that empties into Edges at the Wagon Trade as
 before mentioned beginning at the mouth of said branch at the
 meadows of the branch to the first bottom on the west side said
 branch running South to my line together with one Negro Man named
 Long. I then I Give & bequeath to my Daughter, Mary W. Byrds one
 Negro Girl named Fanny. I then I Will that my whole Stock, Viz.
 Horses, Cattle, Sheep & Pigeons to be sold & Equally Divided amongst
 all my Children, Viz. John Byrd, My eldest Son Byrds, Elizabeth W. Byrd
 Mary W. Byrds, Sarah W. Byrds. David Michell & William Michell

Whom I Constitute & Appoint my Executors of this my last Will &
 Testament, agree this fourth day of October in the Year of our
 Lord one thousand seven hundred & seven hundred & thirtyfour
 signed sealed Published & pronounced as my last Will & Testa-
 ment in presence of us the day & Year above Written

In the Name of God Amen. I John Wharton of the County of New
 & State of North Carolina being sick & weak in body but of perfect mind
 & Memory Thanks be to God for the same, last Calling to mind the
 frailty of the Body & knowing it is appointed for all men once to
 die do make & Ordain This my last Will & Testament In presence
 all other Will or Wills by me hitherto made. Principally I Give
 I Give & bequeath my soul into the hands of Almighty God who
 gave it me & my body I Recommend to the Earth to be buried in a
 decent Christian manner. Hoping to Reunite the same again at the
 General Resurrection. I now I bequeath my worldly Estate whom with it
 has pleased God to bless me with in life. I Give Divide & dispose
 of the same in the following manner & form, Viz. I then Give & bequeath
 my Daughter Mary Wharton her whole & separate Estate on which I have two
 and a half Acres of Land & one Cow & one Horse & one Pig
 & one Sheep & bequeath to my Daughter whose Estate on the
 said & separate One & one half two Acres of Land & one Cow & one Pig
 & one Sheep & one Horse for ever
