Know all men by these presents that I Benjamin Goham of Peters County Tex and in consideration of the sum of Eighty seven pounds Ten Shillings and Sixpence Money to me in hand paid by David Thomson of the said County do hereby acknowledge have bargained sold & delivered & by these presents do bargain sell & deliver unto the said David Thomson of the said County one Male with two Mares future harness one head of Cattle, fifteen head of Hogs four Bushels Two Birds one Bedstead one Loom two Chests and seven other Articles of Household Furniture now in his possession to have and to hold he said Benjamin Goham unto the said David Thomson of the said County Administrators & Assigns forever and I the said Benjamin Goham for myself my Executors & Administrators shall & will Warrant & for ever defend against all persons by these presents he said Benjamin Goham unto the said David Thomson of the said County Administrators & Assigns provided Nevertheless that I & the said Benjamin Goham my Executors & Administrators shall & will well and truly pay or cause to be paid to the said David Thomson of the said County Administrators & Assigns the sum of Eighty seven pounds Ten Shillings and Sixpence Money on the first day of May next ensuing the date hereof with lawful interest for the same for redemption of said Benjamin Goham's promise then the full of cash to be paid or else to remain in full force in which Whose I have hereunto set my hand this second day of November Dr. The sum Eighty pounds & Two
