**Y**OU are forthwith to admeasure and lay out, or cause to be ad-  
measured and laid out, unto *James Hainwright*

a Plantation, containing *Two Hundred*

Acres of Land, in the County of *Will*

*On Cheecod Swamp on the South Side of the Round  
Island joining to Simon Jones Line Including the  
juniper Swamp*

Observing His Majesty's Instructions for running out Lands; Two just and  
fair Plans whereof, with a proper Certificate annexed to each, you are to  
return into the Secretary's Office, within Twelve Months from the Date  
hereof: And if the Warrantee shall not, within Eighteen Months from the  
Date hereof, take out a Patent for the said Lands, this Warrant, and all  
Proceedings thereon, shall be void and of no Force; and the said Land  
shall be deemed vacant, and free to be taken up by any other Person.
