

Pitt County Deed from John Cason to John Moore
5/25/1780

To all to whom these presents shall come Know ye that I John Cason of the county of Pitt and the state of North Carolina, Planter for and in consideration of the sum of fifteen hundred pounds current money of the state of North Carolina to me in hand paid before the ensealing and delivery of these presents by John Moore of said county and state Planter the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge and myself therewith fully and entirely satisfied contented and paid have given granted bargained sold conveyed and confer on and to by these presents do fully freely and absolutely give grant bargain sell alien convey and confirm onto the said John Moore his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the county of Pitt on the south side of Grindle Creek including the plantation whereon the said John Moore now lives and as bounded as follows Beginning at a sweet gum on the Creek Swamp above Henry Coopers old Logg swam running s 40W to James Albrittons back line then North 5 [unclear] to Lemuel James Lie thence with his line S 100 poles to a corner pine thence east 36 poles thence North ? poles to a pine that stands near a pond at a branch ? at a corner pine to the creek thence w 56 poles to a pine being Lemuel James old corner thence the various courses of the creek to the first station containing by estimation 110 acres more or less and being part of a tract of 300 acres of land granted by pattent to George Cannon and part of a tract of 229 acres granted to James Cason by deed from Earl Granville agent. To have and to hold the above granted and sold premises with all the appurtenances there to belonging [illegible] to the same belonging or in any wise appertaining to him that [illegible] acknowledge his heirs and assigns forever to his and their proper use benefit and acknowledge free and clear to peaceably clearly acquitted exonerated and discharged of and from all former gifts grants bargains sales leases jointures dowry judgments executions encumbrances and troubles whatsoever the lawful quit rents or taxes paid by authority of the state only and [illegible] and I the said John Cason do further bind myself my heirs executors administrators and each and every of them firmly and by these presents do warrant and defend the said John Moore his heirs and assigns in [illegible] and peaceable possession of all and singular the herein above granted and bargained premises against all claims or demands of any person or persons whatsoever. paid, have given granted & conveyed & do hereby convey &
& confirm to by these presents do fully, freely & absolutely
give grant & convey all and whole County of Pamlico with
the S. John Moore his heirs & assigns forever, certain
tract or parcel of lands lying and being in the County
of Pitt on the South side of Beaufort Creek including
the plantation whereon the S. John Moore now lives
and is bounded as follows. Beginning at a corner stone
in the Creek Swamp just above Henry's house old Logg
running S 40 W to James Huttons back line then with
line of to Daniel Barnes line thence with his line S
100 poles to a corner point thence E 100 poles to a corner point
thence to a line that stands near a pond a branch that
runs from the Creek thence N 100 poles to a point being corner
James Old, corner thence the various courses of
the Creek to the first Station containing by Calculation
100 acres. Thence up is being part of a tract of 200
of lands granted by patent to George Cannon and
part of a tract of 200 acres granted to James Cannon by
deed from Carl Beadwell Agent To John and to his
the above granted & sold premises with all the appurtenances
thereunto in anywise appertaining to the same

to him the said ~~Thomas Pinckett~~ his heirs and assigns
