KNOW ALL MEN HERETO that I Abraham [Dixson of the] County and State aforesaid, Planter for ? the sum of fifty pounds to me paid before the ensealing and delivery [of these presence] by James Gorham Planter the receipt hereby acknowledged and myself satified and ? paid have given granted bargained set over and conveyed and confimed [illegible] to bargain sell and convey [illieigible] unto the above said James Gorham [his heirs executors and] assigns forever a certain tract of land [missing] lying and being in Pitt Coumnty on [the North] side of Tar River in the n the County Pitt [illigeible] acres of land deeded to Abraham Dixson by his father and mother Edward and Keziah Dixson that they held by deed of gift from Stephen Munden bearing date 5th day of Feb. 1762, Known by the Name of Stephen Munden.. . Tract lies by the ? and Branch, Swamp ...and being one hundred and twenty five acres more or less.
