

Transcribed Deed from John Mundine to his daughter Lucresey Cason,
Sept. 21, 1786
Pitt County Deed Book L/pg 211

To all to whom these presents shall come knowye that I John Mundine Planter of the County of Pitt and State of North Carolina for the love and good will that I have for my daughter Lucresey Cason given granted and bequeathed a certain tract of land beginning at a water oak at Whites corner in the Wolf Pit branch then running up to a pine and corner then east to John Whiteheads line on the cross branch to a pine thence along Whiteheads line to the corner of Chinupin on ? Ridge thence along Whiteheads line to the beginning containing 90 acres more or less TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said granted land with all privileges thereunto belonging or any wise appurtaining unto the said Lucresey Cason her heirs and assigns and to her and hers proper use benefit and behold forever and do hereby bind myself my heirs executors administrators and assigns to warrant and forever defend the above land from the claims of any person or persons whatsoever unto the said Lucresey Cason her heirs administrators and IN WITNESS whereof I have put my hand and seal this 21st day of September 1786.
