Pursuant to the enclosed Order of the Com<sup>rs</sup> Thomas  
 Howell M<sup>tr</sup> (Larkin Swain being absent by sickness  
 & Mathew Lawder being unaccounted for the widow was  
 called to supply his place) - was duly qualified and  
 proceeded to lay off & allot to Wm Jenkins widow of  
 Thomas Jenkins D<sup>y</sup> one year support as follows To wit  
 255 lbs of Bacon on hand. 100 lbs of lard support on  
 hand 500<sup>lbs</sup> of Bacon support on hand. 9 head live  
 Hogs, 5 Hides Cow, 4 Head of Sheep the use of one horse  
 2 loads of black powder 2 loads of Hay, 30 D<sup>y</sup> of  
 salt all the Husks & Straw 10 Gln<sup>s</sup> of Whisky together  
 with all the new cloth, some yarn better flax seed  
 soap & the painting on the D<sup>y</sup> hill - & whereas we  
 find the stock of salt deficient as also the material  
 for clothing the family & further sweetening molasses  
 on hand - we therefore apply the sum of \$33.00  
 Thirty three Dollars to make up the said deficiencies  
 Witness our hands & seals this 28<sup>th</sup> 1820
