2^d That all my property real and personal be sold and the money given to the Overseers of the poor for the use of the poor of said County — After all my debts are paid —

In the name of God amen. Pat. Black Common of the County of Randolph and State of North Carolina being weak in body but of sound mind and memory calling to mind the will and Testament of my dearly loved wife in following viz-

1st And for the charitable acts and care taken for me by my worthy friend William Galtly of the County of Orange ever since the death of my old master Richard Rogers. I have ever been ready to my said friend William Galtly to him and his heirs forever one tract of land in Rowan County on the waters of Rich fork of State Creek for one one hundred acres with to me by my old master Richard Rogers. And where as my said friend old master Rogers settled me in the aforesaid will two tracts one to w^{ts} & one other house that I never received from his master.

Viz- William Bell & Thomas Carson de and it is Desire that my above said friend the Galtly may receive the same aforesaid Black for his own use to him & his heirs forever — I further nominate and appoint my worthy friend William Galtly my sole Executor to this my last will & Testament in writing whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the 6 day of August 1809
