 Thouts three cows & one two year old mare
 I give & bequeath to my son David Thouts
 one hundred Dollars which is to be paid by Jacob
 & Phillip Thouts on account of the land that is
 give to them
 After my decease it is my desire that my Executors
 let the residue of my estate not herebefore devised &
 divide the same equally amongst my daughters Elizabeth
 Catherine Thouts Mary Thouts & Hannah
 Thouts. And I hereby make and ordain my shortly
 friends Jacob Thouts David Thouts executor of this my last will
 & testament. In witness whereof I the said John Thouts have to this my
 last will & testament. Let my hand seal the day & year above
