 the death of my wife Sarah that to be be divided
 as here after Directed

Now fifth my will is that the tracts of my Estate not
 named in my will shall be sold as soon as convenient
 after my decease and the proceeds of the sales to be
 Equally divided between my sons Mark Bush & Ad Bush
 Charles Bush Benjamin Bush Zebulon Bush Amos
 Bush and the heirs of Rachel Bush my son to wife
 Annas Bush Bathsheba Bush & Sarah Bush they
 they having one half the part of the proceeds of said
 sales Now sixth my will is that at the death
 of my wife Sarah that all her personal property she
 may be in or found of be sold & Equally divided between
 my sons Mark Bush and Bush Charles Bush Benjamin
 Bush Zebulon Bush Amos Bush and the heirs of my
 son Rachel Bush making the share of the said Amos
 Bush Bathsheba Bush & Sarah Bush to be one fourth
 part of the proceeds arising from said sales to be Equally divided
 among them the my son daughter

Now seventh I Give & bequeath unto my son daughter
 Mary Wright & Sarah Goff two hundred dollars each

To be paid out of the money arising from the sale of
 my property not named in my will or full of this parts
 or portions of my Estate both real and personal the same
 I hold against Grace Wright to be deducted out of his
 wife Mary Legans a bond bequeathed and the balance
 to be paid over to the said Mary Wright

Now eighth I Give and bequeath unto my daughter
 Bathsheba Andrew son Roger girl by the name of Grace
 of her the death of my wife Sarah that to her and
 her heirs for ever in full of her part or portion of my
 Estate both real & personal, and I do hereby appoint my
 two sons Mark Bush and Zebulon Bush Executors of this my
 Last will & Testament being advising and knowing all the parties
 by me made conforming and attestation that is my last will
 & Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my
 hand and seal the 23 day of July 1819
