State of North Carolina, Know all men by these presents Randolph County, that I Beverly Gallie of the County and State aforesaid Farmer being what of Body but of sound mind and memory, do think proper to make this my last Will and Testament in the disposal of such World's Estate whereunto it hath pleased God to bless me with in the following manner and form. (Says) 1<sup>st</sup> That my Body should be buried in decent or as near my desires. 2<sup>d</sup> My Will is that all my just debts be paid in convenient time after my decease by my Executor hereafter named. 3<sup>d</sup> Then, I give unto my Grand Daughter Polly Brown One Feather Bed and Furniture. 4<sup>th</sup> I give unto my Daughter Dicy Howard five Shillings Current Money. 5<sup>th</sup> I give to my Daughter Nancy Vaughan five Shillings Current Money. 6<sup>th</sup> I give unto my Son James Gallie five Shillings Current Money of this State. 7<sup>th</sup> I give unto my Daughter Amy Gausey five Shillings Current Money of this State. 8<sup>th</sup> I give unto my Son Beverly Gallie One Negro Man named Paul now in my possession. 9<sup>th</sup> Then, I give unto my Daughter Polly Wade one Negro Woman by the name of Anahy which was past in her possession. 10<sup>th</sup> I give unto my Son William Gallie five Shillings Current Money. 11<sup>th</sup> I give unto my Daughter

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Rachel Lutter five Shillings Current Money. 12<sup>th</sup> I give unto my Son Samuel Gallie five Shillings Current Money, also one Negro Girl by the name of Sam. 13<sup>th</sup> Then, I give my Negro Woman by the name of Abby her personal Estate to me and my heirs for ever, and my Will is that at the next General Assembly or Session Court of this County after my decease that she the said Abby be placed according to Law for her education service to me and my family. 14<sup>th</sup> Then, leave Twenty Dollars in the care of my Executors hereafter named in the purchase of clothing the expenses which may accrue in obtaining my Negro Woman Abby's freedom in Court or otherwise, and be the highest of my old Negro Woman Sam. 15<sup>th</sup> And Lastly my Will is that after all the Legacies are paid out and the Expenses in the support of my old Negro Woman Sam and other necessary expenses are paid I give to my Grand Daughter Polly Brown the balance of my estate whomever to be bound. I nominate Executors and a friend my friends John Black and one Benjamin Cookshire Executors to this my last Will and Testament Watching and Confirming this and no other to contain my last Will and Testament, in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal June the 9<sup>th</sup> day 1824.
