 of the County of Randolph, being very Sick &
 Weak in body but of perfect Mind & Memory think
 he gives unto God, Calling to mind the mortality
 of my Body, and knowing that it is appointed for
 all Men to die, do make and ordain this my last
 Will & Testament —

I Give & bequeath Magdalena my darling beloved
 Wife My Land and the benefits thereof during her life
 or widowhood then to belong to my son Edward except
 fifty acres among the land of George Black which
 is to be paid by my Executor I Likewise Give my
 Wife all the Silver & Gold & Jewellery and
 I among Wintates two Shirts & 2 Coats & give
 Shoop and the whole Stock of Hogs and one
 Wagon my daughter Catharine is let me as
 much property as my other daughters have got
 out of my Estate My son Edward is to be that in
 School twelve months to come out of my Estate
 Likewise I Give to my son John ten Shillings I also
 Give my son Abraham ten Shillings I also Give
 my daughter Christian ten Shillings I also Give
 my daughter Ann ten Shillings I also Give
 daughter Magdalene ten Shillings I also Give
 daughter Catharine ten Shillings I also Give
 my son Edward ten Shillings

I Also Give My Son Shalom an addition of
 Forty dollars to make him Equal With My other sons
 Also all such property as not specially mentioned in
 My last will & Testament is to be Sold and the
 Money arising from such Sale is to remain in the
 Hands of My Executor And in case My Wife
 Magdalena Should Die With any children then
 She is to be Maintained out of the same also at
 the time of her death or clearance this Money
 Together With the Money arising from the Sale of
 the property left herein this My Last Will & Testament
 is to be Equally divided among my children I also
 constitute make and ordain my Son Shalom
 Executor of the bequeath & devise Sole Executor of
 this My Last Will & Testament do allow revoke and discharge
 All and Every other Will or Testament Anticipating this
 And confirming this & no other to be My Last Will
 & Testament or Anticipating before of I have hereunto set
 My hand and affixed My Seal this 24 day of ~~July~~
 January 1816
