

28 Know all men by these presents that I Daniel Clark of Randolph County & State of North Carolina being of sound Disposing mind & memory do make And ordain this my last will & testament in manner and form following. First, I will that all the Just Debts that I shall owe to any person or persons, at the time of my decease be well & truly paid and Discharged within convenient time out of my personal estate

I then I give & bequeath unto my beloved wife Mary Clark the use profit & income of all my estate both real & personal while she remains my widow. but if she marries again my will is she shall have the use only of an equal share with all my children and at the decease or marriage of my wife - I then I give & bequeath unto my children namely, Martha, John, Ann Elizabeth, Samuel, & Mary Clark all my estate both real & personal to be equally Divided between them not preferring one before another, but if any of my children decease without having lawful issue my will is his, her, or their parts, or parts be equally Divided among the survivors -

29 And lastly I constitute, appoint & make my beloved wife Mary Clark & my friend John Long Jr. Executors & Executor jointly of this my last will and Testament in writing Whereof I have to these presents set my hand & seal this twenty first day of the seventh month in the year of our lord one thousand eight hundred & twelve signed sealed pronounced & declared by the said Daniel Clark to be his last will & Testament in presence of us -
