I hereby Lamb of Randolph County & State of North Carolina being in a weak state of health, at present, but of sound mind & memory think be given in the last of the same and calling to mind that it is appointed for all men once to die, do declare and Make this my last will and Testament in the manner and form follow viz First that all my task Debt & several Charges be paid out of my Estate by my Executors hereafter to be named it is my will that my son Richard Lamb shall have the plantation whereon we live with all the appurtenances thereto belonging on this side the Creek and my son Gabriel to have all on the west side the Creek its a plantation on which he now lives the Creek is to be the line between them it is my will that my son Richard shall have the bigger & greater it is my will that my son Henry & his Daughter Melvill & their have five Shillings each & the remainder of my property to be equally divided between my other Children, Benjamin Nathan, Charity, Catharine, Salter, Richard & Gabriel & lastly I ordain Nathan Lamb & Richard Lamb my Executors to this my last will & Testament this Twenty
