the State of North Carolina and County of Randolph
being of sound & perfect mind and memory do hereby the
fourteenth day of October in the year of our Lord
1808 Make and publish this my last Will & Testament
in the manner following that is to say —
First I give & Bequeath to my Beloved wife Mary
the plantation where now live together with the
forming thereof, consisting of plow land acres &c —
and my best Negro or and the following Negro Mary
Tobin, Adams Dick and Mully and two of my best
Cows and four head of my best Cows & Baby six head of
sheep a good killing of hogs, sufficient for her family
consumption for One year and three cows &c —
Four feather Beds and furniture one Desk and the best
Child Kitchen Furniture, consisting of Pot & Oven & other
sufficient for her to keep upon the above property
to be kept by her for her use & support, During her
natural life, and at her decease, to be returned to the
personal Estate of the above named Frederick Turner
and all to be sold & given to Lewis Nipper
Mully excepted who is to be left to my Daughter
Mary and the money arising out of such sale
to be equally divided between my four Daughters
To Wit Leah Martha Mary & Leah —
2. Give unto my Daughter Leah my Negro Woman
Dolly the Indian, my Negro Boy Isaac & my
Gamb Doll

3^d- I give unto my Daughter Martha my Negro Girl
Bekah and her increase - my Negro Boy Ned
and my Negro girl Puffin.
4th- I give unto my Daughter Mary Two hundred
acres of Land and my Negro fellow-servant
and my Negro girl Mitty at the Desire of her
Mother and her increase,
5th- I give unto my Daughter Tabitha 180 Acres
of land whereon she now lives and my
Negro girl Fanny - my Negro girl Dorcas -
Catty Hurby - Ordain and make my country friend
Benjamin Steeds and Caleb Steeds Executors of
this my last will and Testament in contrabundance
I the said Frederick Farmer have to this my last
will and Testament set my hand and seal at the
city & c. as above written
