 I give to my daughter Hannah Dec'd wife of Eldridge Seaton
 one Chest and one Copper kettle one feather bed and
 I give to Sophia Seaton's daughter of Eldridge Seaton
 and her son his wife one small bed & one covered box
 Chest Counterpane. I give to my son John five shillings
 Seaton one Red Lion Bath white Coat and one before
 seat Dressing gown which will be in the year on
 the second Eight hundred & 100. I give to Eldridge Seaton
 this year he is to pay Dec'd he has obliged to pay
 and the same is to be divided among all my Children
 except John Constant, and my bond Swills and bridle
 one Cattle Horn, some Corn some Oats some Flax
 Harrow and the Mowing Scythe Witness all my
 Children except John Constant my son, he is to have
 but the five shillings I have left him I leave William
 Cook and Betty Spinks my Executors - and my bond
 must be sold after the same is out and the money
 divided among all my Children equally except John
 Constant, by Witness whereof I have hereunto set my
 hand and affixed my seal the day & date above
