In the Name of God amens. I John Rain of Randolph County of
North Carolina. being weak no body but perfect in Sence and
Memory - desired to dyd. Do make this my Last will and Testement
Imprimis. I give unto my son John Rain an equal part of my goods
Except the Land I have - I give unto my two Sons George Rain &
John Rain my lands that I now live on to be Equally
Divided betwix them when they come of age to them and their
heirs for ever.
Item I give unto my loving wife Sarah Rain an equal
Divide with all my Children - I stnd. I give to all my
Children and Equal part of all my Goods and Chattels
I do hereby Constitute my trusty Brother Lawrence Rain and
my Son George Rain to be sole Executrix of this my last
will and Testement. hereby Revoking and Disannulling all former
Wills and Testaments. In witness whereof to all and every part
of the said will and Testement I have hereunto set my hand
and Seal this 17th Day of January 1790 —

of Virginias for & in consideration of two hundred
Silver Dollars to me in hand paid by Nathl. Clark of
Randolph County & State of North Carolina the Plaintiff
whereof I do hereby acknowledge have bargained &
and sold and by law present to bargain and sell unto
the said Nathl. Clark one Negroe Boy named Will to
have and to hold the said Negroe Boy to his Execution
or life time for ever and to the said John Rain Pickett for
my self my my Execution and Administrator
the said Negroe in above named unto the said Nathl. Clark
here his heirs & assigns against me the said John Rain
Pickett my Execution Administrator or assigns or any
other person or persons whatsoever. Longfurther claiming
the said Negroe boy shall & will warrant & provide
Defend by these presents in witness whereof I have here
unto set my hand & affixed my Seal this 23rd Day of
August 1791
