In the Name of God Amen I John Rindal of the County of Randolph & State of North Carolina being weak in body but of sound & perfect mind & Memory testify to Mind that it is appointed for all Men to die do Make This My last will & Testament in Manner & form following - Firstly it is my will & desire that all my Just debts & funeral Expenses sh^l be paid by my Executors hereinafter named. Then I Give & bequeath unto my beloved wife Elizabeth Rindal one fourth part of my lands including my Dwelling house & out houses during her life time. In Wile she lives, my widow for the support of herself and the Children Under age & on her Marriage or death to be disposed of as hereafter directed I also Give & bequeath unto my said wife one Cow one Feather bed & furniture & one shackle I also bequeath the remainder of my moveable property not herein particularly devised during her widowhood for the purchase of Bibles & Education ^{for} the Children and at her Marriage or death it is my will that my said Moveable Effects sh^l be Equally divided between my five Children Hannah James, Gale, Thomas Wisa & Eliza except such parts of the said personal property as is herein hereafter otherwise directed - Then my Sons Thomas Rindal & Nathan Rindal & My daughters, Lydia James, Sally Rindal

& Ruth, Hannah & Nancy Carter & the Slaves of my daughter Samuel they having all
 readily received what I intended for them I hope they will be Content. These with
 John Gore & Benjamin unto my daughter Hannah's household one Bawer one bed & furniture one
 Cow & Cow Dollen on Money to buy her a saddle. - Also I Give & bequeath to my dear Sister
 Hannah the use of Fifty Dollars to be kept at Interest by me I intend & the entire of them to
 her use during her life & at her death the principal to be paid over to her law full heirs -
 Also I Give & bequeath unto my Son John Samuel James - Thomas & John all the lands to be
 Equally divided Amongst them Likewise to these Mother the use of her full dower her bed
 & trink I also Give to my Son the last which one I say made a bequest to her -
 I do further will & bequeath that my Executors hereafter named shall sell such portion of Black
 plantation Cows & household utensils as can with convenience be spared or might go to waste
 before them to whom it is bequeathed the sum of one hundred & fifty dollars for the purpose of paying the Money
 hereafter above mentioned - I will further bequeath to my Son John Samuel & Benjamin
 I Give Executors of this my last will & Testament Executors by their parents, all other well or
 better by me hereafter made & to be paid the said sum of one hundred & fifty dollars of the
 said John Samuel have hereunto set my hand & Seal the 10th day of October in the
 year one thousand Eight Hundred & Seventy one - Signed Sealed published & declared by
 the Testator in the presence of us
