26<sup>th</sup> of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Mo 1816 I Seth Beeson of the County of Hen-  
 rypeth and State of North Carolina Being of sound  
 mind and Memory Hoped in the Lord for the same  
 but calling to mind that it is appointed for all men  
 once to die do make this my last will & testament  
 which is as follows To my body to be buried 2<sup>d</sup> All  
 my Debts and General Charges to be paid —  
 3<sup>d</sup> To my beloved wife Rebecca to her her was  
 my apparel with her saddle and one feather bed &  
 my furniture to be at her disposal during life — 4<sup>th</sup> And as  
 I am a Father I wish that she should have a Maintenance of 1/3 of my plan-  
 tation and have the privilege of house & barn with fire  
 wood & Wear with my Children and such as may proper  
 by as she with my Executors shall be judged necessary  
 for her to keep both within Decent Limit of her own  
 I do hereby give and bequeath all the Lands I do  
 own here my Lands to be divided equally amongst my three  
 Sons Isaac David & Dixon Equally according to Value  
 (and to my daughter Elizabeth it is my will that  
 she shall have all the household furniture — my  
 Cash & Cash notes be applied in giving my children  
 reasonable education & if there be any thing remain-  
 ing at the time that they shall come of age it to be  
 Equally divided amongst ~~the~~ all my children  
 My Executors is the Baron my Brother & Wm Cham-  
 bers
