I Jacob Newman being in a law State of Health but of a sound mind & memory bless be God, do this 30th day of October 1822. doth make and publish this my last Will and Testament in the following manner, that is to say, my Debt and Financial Expenses to be paid first. I give and bequeath to my loving Wife all my Lands, two Slaves the Bay & Black, my Stock of Cattle, and Hogs & Sheep except such as I hereafter mention & all household furniture during her life as Widowhood.

2^d. I give & bequeath to my Son Leonard Fifty Dollars. 3^d. I give and bequeath to my Daughter Sarah Twenty Dollars. 4th. I give and bequeath to my Son Liza Fifty Acres Land when he lives by him paying back Fifty Dollars. 5th. I give and bequeath to my Son Jacob Fifty Dollars meaning the fifty that to be paid by Liza. 6th. I give & bequeath to my Son William fifty Cents. 7th. I give and bequeath to my Son Isaac fifty Cents. 8th. I give & bequeath to my daughter Mary Twenty Dollars Real Estate, Lot of Punter Place, Dick and Parson.

9th. I give & bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth Twenty Dollars Real Estate, Lot of Punter Place, Dick and Parson. 10th. I give & bequeath to my Son Jacob Fifty Dollars & some worth Twenty five Dollars & Parcel. 11th. I give & bequeath to my Daughter Liza Twenty Dollars Real Estate, Lot of Punter Place, Dick and Parson. 12th. I give & bequeath to my Daughter Frances Twenty Dollars Real Estate, Lot of Punter Place, Dick and Parson. 13th. I give and bequeath to my Son George Fifty Dollars & a Bay Horse called Billy, Fyge & Parson, the four last named. I wish to be paid their parts in Silver that is now in hand at the death of my Widow, I wish the property equally divided between all my Children, the Stock and Wages to be sold for the purpose of schooling the Young Children or any thing the Widow think proper to sell for the use of the family. I make and confirm my two Sons Liza and Liza Executors to this my last Will and Testament, In Witness whereof I set my hand and seal the day and Year first above Written.

First I most humbly bequeath my Soul to God my maker beseeching his most generous acceptance of it through the all sufficient merits and mediation of my most compassionate Redeemer Jesus Christ who gave himself to be an atonement for my sins and is able to do so to the uttermost all that come unto God by him seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them and who I trust will not reject me a returning penitent sinner when I come to him for mercy in this hope and confidence, I commend up my Soul with comfort humbly beseeching the most blessed and glorious Trinity God most holy most merciful and generous to prepare me for the time of my dissolution and then to take me to himself into that peace and rest and incomparable felicity which he has prepared for all that love and fear his holy Name. Amen. blessed be God, I give my body to the Earth from whence it was taken in full assurance of its Resurrection from thence at the last day, as in my Decree I desire it may be decent without form or State at the discretion of my dear Wife and my Executors hereafter named who I doubt not will manage it with all requisite prudence, as to my worldly Estate I will and positively order that all my debts be paid.
