I John Davison of Randolph County and State of North Carolina being in health of Body and of perfect mind and memory and knowing the Mortality of my Body and that it is appointed for all men once to die, do hereby this fifteenth of January in the Year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and Eighty five make and declare this my last Will and Testament in the following manner and as touching such worldly Estate as it hath pleased the Lord to give me with I bequeath give devise and assign it as follow: First I allow my Funeral Charges and last debts to be paid out of my Estate, Secondly I declare and constitute John Warr and Samuel Cook my whole and sole Executors and Trustees of this my last Will and Testament as Trustees of the whole, I leave to my Son John Davison all my Land that I possess at my death, I likewise leave to my Son Samuel Davison Twenty Shillings, I leave to my Son James Davison five Shillings, I leave my Daughter Mary Cook five Shillings, I leave to my Son John Davison five Shillings, I leave to my Daughter Rachel Brown five Shillings, I leave to my Daughter Sarah Osburn five Shillings, I leave to my Daughter Deborah Cook five Shillings, I leave to my Son William Davison five Shillings, I leave to my Daughter Mary Cook one Shilling, I leave to my Son John Davison one Shilling and the rest of my property to be sold and the Money to be equally divided among my Children, In Witness and Testimony whereof I John Davison have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal the day and Year above written, Legua in the presence of us,

In the name of Our Saviour - I Matthias Perry of the County of Randolph and State of North Carolina having been Sick and weak in Body but of perfect mind and memory thanks be given unto God calling unto witness the mortality of the body, and knowing that it is always appointed for all men once to die, do make and declare this my last Will and Testament, that I do my whole body and kind of all - I give and recommend - I send into the hands of Almighty God that give it, and my Body I recommend to the Earth to be buried in a decent Christian burial, at the discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God, and as touching such worldly Estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless me with, in this life, I give, devise, and assign of the same, in the following manner, and thus I Test. I give and bequeath to Sarah my dear wife one hundred and thirty five Acres of Land above and below the River of the North Carolina and also the Wagon and Teams and two Cows and other Farming Tools, to serve on the farm, also I give the Slave, now live on to my Wife during her life or Widowhood of the Master to go to my Son David the above Land mentioned being in Randolph County and Chatham County, also I give to my Son John Perry and John also the Land in the County of Chatham and also the Land in the County of Chatham, my Son David to have the use of the above Land and also a Store to work the Land and my Son David to give his Mother the half that he makes on the Land, and that is made on the Land, the Son only to work in a throng of work, I also give and bequeath to my Son John the plantation he now lives on price Five hundred Dollars, I also give to my Son Thomas four hundred Dollars in Money in the room of the Land that I gave him and purchase from him again, I also give to my Son Herman the Tract of Land he now lives on in Chatham County three hundred and forty two Acres, price four hundred Dollars, I also give to my Son Matthias the Tract of Land he now lives on being in Randolph County and Chatham County containing two hundred Acres price four hundred Dollars, I also give to my Daughter Sarah, Catharine, Maria, Elizabeth, and Pauls Children the sum of one hundred Dollars to each of my Daughters, I also excepted, her Children to have their Mother share one hundred Dollars, this to be paid out of my Estate before any other share is made, I also devise that my two Daughters Maria, Deborah and have one Cow and Servitude and a Cow and Gallina and two Pigs one Spout one Pot and one Spoon and two Cows, this to be given to each of them to make them even with the other, I my Daughter that is married and left me - Hannah to have one Parcel of Land I also leave to my Wife seven head of three Year of Hogs, and
