The Conditions of the above Bargain and Sale is such that if the above Bond John Lewis shall pay unto the said James Patterson & Co. on or before the first day of December next the full and true sum of Four hundred & thirty seven pounds four Shillings & six pence half penny then the above Bargain & Sale to be Void or Else to Remain in full force & Virtue And Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this 1st day of August 1845
