day by the said Compt. one Hogshead with four bushels  
one large black Horse (say it hain't Night) between the ages  
of eight & Twelve years and one half dozen Hens from forth  
Ward South high about 15 dozen years old also two hundred  
acres land lying in the County of Randolph Below the mouth  
of Sandy Creek & adjoining the land of Stephen Lewis John Lewis  
& Joseph Hanson. The condition of the above Bargain and  
Sale is such that if the above bound John Lewis shall  
pay unto the said James Patterson & Compt. on or before  
the first day of December next the sum and sum total of  
Two hundred & thirty seven pounds four Shillings & Seven  
pence half penny then the above Bargain & Sale to be  
Paid or else to remain in force & Valid till the  
Month of November & my hand & seal this 21  
day of August 1785
