

That my will and desire is that all my Just debts be paid out of my estate by my executors as quick as possible—
 Second I give and bequeath to my wife Margery the plantation where I now live house and house and house hold furniture during her natural life and after her decease to my two sons Leonard and John & their heirs I give to my two daughters Mary and Elizabeth each a horse saddle and bridle to be valued at least to forty Dollars apiece also a good bed and furniture & a cow and calf each I give to my son Samuel my gray horse and bridle at my decease I give to my son William fifty dollars at the decease of my wife or at her discretion all the balance of my estate such as Negroes ^{to stock} I give to my wife Margery during her life and after her death to be equally divided between four of my children viz— Leonard Mary John & Elizabeth I constitute & appoint my wife Margery & son Samuel Executors to this my last will and testament in witness where of I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 5th day of January 1811 John ^{his} X Graves ^{Test}
