John Love should have my whole Estate both Real
Personal to be his, and his heirs Ever;

I do, ^{therefore} appoint leave Benjamin Cleaman Clerk of
Ellice Executor of my Last Will & Testament
Revoking disannulling Making Void all other Wills or
Wills made by me before this present date signed sealed
and pronounced the tenth of the Twelfth month One Thousand
Eighteen hundred & eightieth
